

Guesthouses: Tarn Country House, The Crags, Plettenberg Bay, Garden Route, Western Cape.

Family-owned 100-Ha farm where the Outeniqua and the Tsitsikamma Mountains overlap. Complete tranquillity surrounded by a beautiful garden, extensive indigenous forest, abundant birdlife and breathtaking views and walks in the forest. Charmingly decorated, spacious en-suite bedrooms. Fine cuisine by Guy from the provencal kitchen includes ostrich, springbok, seafood and Mauritian French Creole. Traditional braais under starry skies. Sports nearby include deep-sea fishing, trout fishing, tennis, golf and horse riding. 2-km from spectacular coastline and beaches. French spoken.

Plettenberg Bay is on the N2 east of George, which is at the intersection of the N2 with the N12. Travel east from Plettenberg Bay over the Keurbooms River Bridge. Tarn is on the left, 9.2-km from the bridge. Travelling east from Port Elizabeth, it is 19.2-km west of the Toll Gate, past the turnoff to Nature's Valley (R102). BJTarn

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
